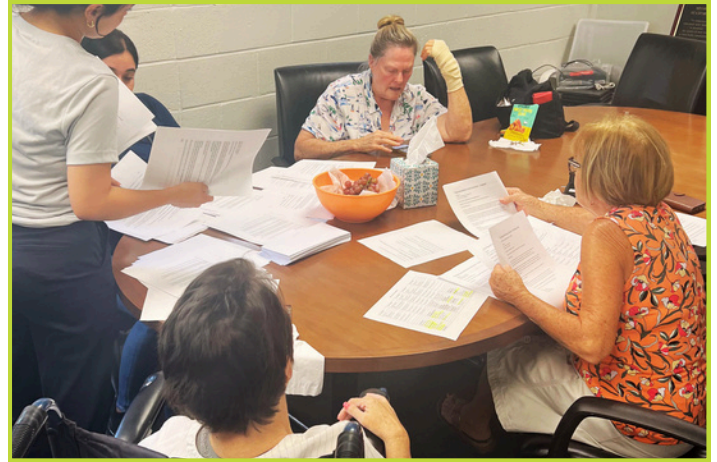

MAKING VOICES HEARD, CAPC, INC. WRITES TO LOCAL LEADERS



Last month on August 12, **CAPC, Inc.** hosted **Advocacy Letter Writing Day** at our Whittier office where consumers, staff, family members, and advocates joined forces creating a space of empowerment and community action.



Together they reviewed and signed letters CAPC, Inc. drafted to elected officials across local communities, including representatives from Whittier, Pico Rivera, Santa Fe Springs, Orange and Los Angeles County. These letters highlighted the urgent need to reconsider the recently passed “The Big Beautiful Bill”, which has created significant impacts on individuals with IDD. Thank you to all who were able to show up and advocate, we were able to acquire at least 20 participants who signed multiple letters to various representatives in the city which they reside in, demanding a call for action to protect the rights of disability community.



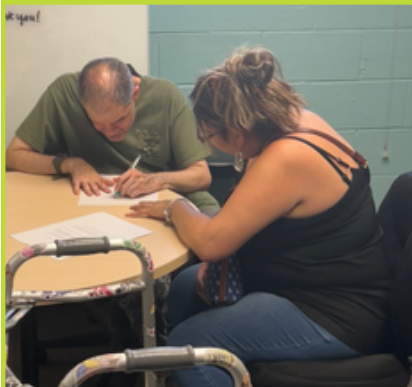
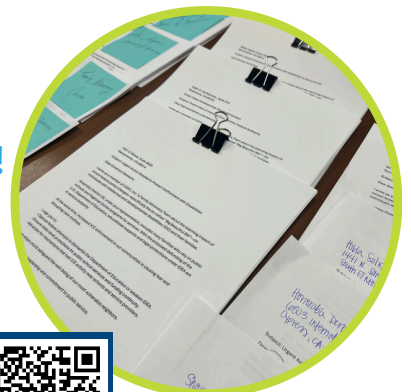

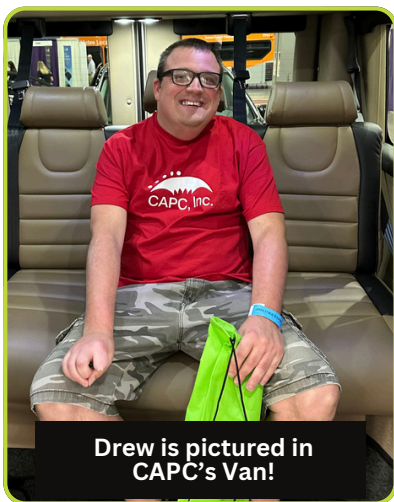
